

**Spoken With Blood: The Implicit Expectations of the New Covenant  
Hebrews 10:19-25**

**I. The Source of the Challenges (10:19-21)**

**Note:** Christ's sacrifice was so great and so mighty that it tore open the curtain that separated man from God (SIN!) and as such made the way for all who surrender to Him to live eternally secure in a covenant relationship with God. As such we forever have the right to approach Him with the \_\_\_\_\_ of a son with his father because He has adopted us as His children!

**II. The Specific Expectations (10:22-25)**

- A. The glory of all that Christ has provided us has a built in expectation that we will live gladly \_\_\_\_\_ and worshiping Him. (10:22)
- B. The glory of all that Christ has provided us has a built in expectation that we will never stop living our lives \_\_\_\_\_ on the pure and undefiled Gospel of Jesus Christ! (10:23)
- C. The glory of all that Christ has provided us has a built in expectation that we will regularly gather \_\_\_\_\_ to worship God and thus encourage one another to love and obey Him! (10:24-25)

**Challenge:** If you claim to be a believer then measure your life against the built in expectations of living in covenant with Him and be honest about what the \_\_\_\_\_ in your life demonstrates. Cry out Him to revive your heart with the truth of what He has given you and to give you the courage to live as you are – HIS!
