

**Spoken With Blood: What Does God Want From Me? Part 5**  
**Proclaim The Gospel!**  
**Hebrews 13:10-15**

**(1) 2 Fundamental truths about what we have in the Gospel. (13:10-12)**

- A. The salvation offered by Christ is \_\_\_\_\_ attainable through the Old Covenant religious regulations, sacrifices and rituals. (13:10)
- B. The imagery presented by Christ's sacrifice for sin on a cross outside the City/outside the religious center and "holy place" highlights that His offering for sin is eternally more \_\_\_\_\_ for all in Christ than the offering given on the Day of Atonement for Israel. (13:11-12)

**(2) 2 Inherent Challenges that come out of what we have in the Gospel. (13:13-15)**

- A. Do not make the New Covenant in Christ a religious effort or a cultural \_\_\_\_\_! (13:13-14)
- B. Proclaim and promote Christ and all He has accomplished for us (\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_) as opposed to some religious version or complication of it! (13:15)

**Challenge:** What are you \_\_\_\_\_ to your family, friends, neighbors, etc.? Are you communicating a cultural Christianity of religious values, rules, expectations etc. or are you proclaiming the actual transformational, genuine, eternal relationship with God that is exclusively provided by Christ and all He accomplished for us? Are you yourself being transformed by the Gospel so that what you share with others about Jesus helps explain to them what they have already seen at work in you?
