- (1) Job _____ like both his friends and God are treating him like an enemy, but yet, he still believes God will see his integrity and declare his innocence. (Job 16-17)
- (2) Bildad the Shuhite responds to Job by saying his future will not end in a declaration of innocence but rather with even greater wrath! (Job 18)
- (3) In the midst of this horrible experience Job doesn't believe his life will ever be restored to what it was, however, he shockingly believes God will _____ him before he dies! (Job 19)
