

## A Wrong View of God's Judgement on The Wicked

Job 20-21

**(1)** Zophar wrongly believes God's judgement on the wicked is to remove their health and prosperity while they are \_\_\_\_\_ and/or by cursing their descendants to a life of disgrace and poverty. – Job 20

**(2)** Job rightly argues that there is no evidence anywhere that suggests God \_\_\_\_\_ punishes the wicked in this life, but, in Job's current broken emotional state, he seems to suggest there is never any justice for the wicked, which is totally incorrect.

**CONCLUSION:** Christ Himself taught and guaranteed through His own resurrection, that those who are righteous (born again!) will be resurrected and blessed with an indescribable glorious life for all eternity, while those who are wicked (not born again) will be resurrected to eternally suffer the most severe punishment possible (Hell).
