Psalm 90
Inspiration to See Things Through His Perspective

"Book Four" *"From Everlasting to Everlasting* A Prayer Of Moses, The man Of God."

-Describe something God radically changed your perspective on

There are two parts to Psalm 90 concerning God's perspective:

Psalm 90:1-11 demonstrates that God's perspective on the universe, life, and our individual lives ALWAYS flows from His eternal nature and holiness.

(1) God always sees things from the perspective of being the ONLY ONE who has eternally existed and is eternally sovereign in all things. (90:1-6)

-What is the meaning of some of the pictures used to describe God's sovereignty in this Psalm?

-Compare or Describe humanity against the sovereignty of God

-How has your perspective on time changed over the years?

-How do you handle time differently?

(2) God always sees things from the perspective of His judgment on SIN. (90:7-11)

-What was Moses experiencing as he wrote this Psalm?

-Describe God's view of you from this Psalm

-Read Romans 3:9-18: Discuss your depravity related to this passage

-Read 1 Corinthians 15:50-57: Discuss the doctrine of glorification from this passage

-Someone share the Gospel in less than 1 minute

-Someone share their testimony in less than 1 minute

Psalm 90:12-17 gives us four WISE responses to seeing the universe, life, and our lives from God's perspective.

(1) Ask God for the wisdom to properly understand and USE our limited days. (9:12)

-Have you been convicted, recently, over anything related to your use of time?

(2) Ask God for JESUS to come back! (9:13)

-Do you have any reservations about desiring Jesus' immediate return?

(3) Ask God for the PEACE and JOY that only come through faith in the knowledge of His love! (9:14-15)

-How could your faith alter where you are struggling with peace and/or joy?

(4) Ask God to make our life and labor in this world productive and meaningful **BEYOND** this life! (9:16-17)

-What is something that is not productive, but you have a hard time letting go of it?

-What is something productive that you need to take on?

Challenge: Are you a saved child of God choosing to live like a **FOOL**? Are you chasing the wind or trusting and following God?
