**A Roadmap for Living In Exile**  
**Submission in Marriage – Part 2**  
**1 Peter 3:7**

**Genesis 2:18-22 provides two clear proofs that God made man to be the leader of the marriage and family.**

- (1) The Hebrew word for “\_\_\_\_\_” means assistant and necessarily implies being under the leadership of the one being helped. God made Eve to be Adam’s helper. (Genesis 2:18)
- (2) God brought the woman to Adam to name demonstrated that God was giving Adam \_\_\_\_\_ over her as his wife. (Genesis 2:19-22)

**Genesis 2 also provides us with two very important clarifications.**

- (1) Creating Eve to be Adam’s helper was not degrading. The Bible uses the word to describe God! It implies a \_\_\_\_\_ not value. (Psalm 33:20, Hosea 13:9)
- (2) One of the reasons God created a woman from a man was to demonstrate that the purpose of marriage is not authority but \_\_\_\_\_. (Genesis 2:19-24)

**1 Peter 3:7 teaches five keys for a Christian husband to faithfully live out the principle of submission in his marriage.**

- (1) A husband must understand that his leadership of the marriage isn’t for his \_\_\_\_\_ but his wife’s. – “7 Likewise, husbands,”
- (2) A husband must see his wife’s \_\_\_\_\_ through her eyes. – “live with your wives in an understanding way,”
- (3) Other than God Himself, a husband must view and treat his wife as the most \_\_\_\_\_ entity in his life. – “showing honor to the woman as the weaker vessel,”
- (4) A husband must always realize his wife has the same \_\_\_\_\_ with God as he does. - “since they are heirs with you of the grace of life,”
- (5) A husband must understand that how he treats others, especially his wife, necessarily effects his \_\_\_\_\_ with the Lord. – “so that your prayers may not be hindered.”

**Challenge:** Would your wife say the leadership of your home is \_\_\_\_\_ and giving life to her and your children, or is it about being empowered and getting life from them?
