The world's upside-down system of determining my self-worth is as follows:

(1)	What I and how well I perform determines my value.
(2)	My determines the type and level of acceptance I receive from others.
(3)	How I'm determines my self-worth.
(4)	Self-worth then depends entirely on what I perform and how well I performing it.
	The Gospel is God's right-side up system that declares my self-worth.
(1)	God adopted me as one of His favored children because He loves me. –(Ephesians 1:3-6)
(2)	Christ died for me because I'm worth that much to Him. –! (Ephesians 1:7-10)
(3)	The Holy Spirit is working in and through me so that I can accomplish things that match His glory! –! (Ephesians 1:11-12; 2:8-10)
Challenge: The Gospel only inoculates us against depression when we live our lives from it. What system are you living your life in?	

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
