

**Kingmaker: The Qualities of a Godly Influencer**  
**1 Samuel 11**

1 Samuel 11 contains 5 eye-opening events that led to a total change in Israel's vibe:

- (1) Nahash, \_\_\_\_\_ of the Ammonites, besieged the Israelite city of Jabesh-gilead. - 11:1-2
- (2) Instead of seeking the \_\_\_\_\_ of their new king, the leaders of Jabesh-gilead sent word to every tribal leader in Israel. - 11:3
- (3) Saul threatened to kill the livestock of any \_\_\_\_\_ unwilling to go to war with him against Nahash. - 11:4-7
- (4) Saul and the Israelites \_\_\_\_\_ the Ammonites. - 11:8-11
- (5) Saul opted to use the victory not as an opportunity to turn his supporters against those who ignored his Kingship, but rather to give \_\_\_\_\_ and unite the nation around him as King. (11:12-15)
