## Kingmaker: The Qualities of a Godly Influencer 1 Samuel 11 Unifier

1 Samuel 11 contains 5 eye-opening events that led to a total change in Israel's vibe:

- (1) Nahash, \_\_\_\_\_\_ of the Ammonites, besieged the Israelite city of Jabesh-gilead. 11:1-2
- (2) Instead of seeking the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of their new king, the leaders of Jabesh-gilead sent word to every tribal leader in Israel. 11:3
