1 Samuel 8

In 1st Samuel 8 there are two examples of foolish actions that resulted in terribly consequential results for Israel.

- (1) Samuel, an otherwise Godly leader, _____ delegated the power to judge Israel to his two sinful sons, and it opened the door for the people to rationalize turning from God! (8:1-5)
- (2) Knowing full well the tyranny they were signing up for, the Israelites still _____ a human King! (8:6-22)
