

**Contrast: The Difference of a Life In Christ**  
**Security vs. Insecurity – Part 1**  
**Believe Your Value**  
**1 Samuel 18:1-30**

**Descriptions of a SECURE Person** – Confident, humble, brave, build, steady, hold up, patient, reliable, optimistic, focused, intentional, giving, forgiving, content, sympathetic, redemptive, trusting, peaceful, wise, loving.

**Descriptions of an INSECURE Person** – Timid, arrogant, afraid, destroys, erratic, lets down, impatient, unreliable, pessimistic, scattered, reactive, demanding, bitter, jealous, callous, revengeful, cynical, turbulent, foolish, selfish.

**The story of 1 Samuel 18 has two distinct themes highlighting the difference between a secure and an insecure person:**

- (1) Jonathan genuinely loved and honored \_\_\_\_\_ even though David was quickly becoming more popular than Jonathan. (18:1-5)
  
- (2) David sincerely and loyally served \_\_\_\_\_, who ironically feared David's popularity and hated him for it. (18:6-30)

**Security Key #1:** Define your value by God's \_\_\_\_\_ (the blood of Jesus), not man's! (1 Corinthians 6:19b-20a, 1 Peter 1:18-19, Revelation 5:9)
