Descriptions of a SECURE Person – Confident, humble, brave, build, steady, hold up, patient, reliable, optimistic, focused, intentional, giving, forgiving, content, sympathetic, redemptive, trusting, peaceful, wise, loving.

Descriptions of an INSECURE Person – Timid, arrogant, afraid, destroys, erratic, lets down, impatient, unreliable, pessimistic, scattered, reactive, demanding, bitter, jealous, callous, revengeful, cynical, turbulent, foolish, selfish.

The story of 1 Samuel 18 has two distinct themes highlighting the difference between a secure and an insecure person:
