The story of 1 Samuel 20 has three parts that point us to an essential Gospel Truth for living a secure life.

- (1)** Jonathan was innocently _____ about his dad, Saul. (20:1-3)
- (2)** Jonathan deepened his covenant with David and agreed to objectively _____ his dad's heart. (20:4-23)
- (3)** Johnathan _____ his loyalty to David when he saw his father's insecure, self-centered, foolish heart. (20:24-42)

Security Key #1: Define your value by God's appraisal (the blood of Jesus), not man's!

Security Key #2: Believe your future in Christ is guaranteed and better than anything this world offers.

Security Key #3: Believe that you are _____ by God and those who know God's love. (1 John 3:10, 4:20a)
