	B.	Step Two – Create incorrect perceptions about the leadership. (15:2-3)
	C.	Step Three – Present yourself as a (15:4)
	D.	Step Four – Useto win friends and influence people. (15:5-6)
	E.	Step Five – Make it appear you're doing everything for (15:7-9)
	F.	Step Six – cue your supporters to publicly proclaim you as King. (15:10-12)
(2)	Absalom's betrayal shook David enough to finally wake him up from his (15:13-30)
